Rec Havoc

Information and Rules

I/WSA invites you, your teammates and families to enjoy your experience at this year's Rec Havoc adult hockey tournament. We aim for a quality hockey and social experience. With the cooperation of all players, coaches and team officials, we're confident that everyone will have a great time at our tournament.

Playing Rules:

USA Hockey playing rules will be followed. All divisions will play no-check. All players must be registered with USA Hockey for the 09-10 playing season. **The tournament director reserves the right to place any team in the appropriate division.** The schedule will be posted on the I/WSA web site www.iwsa.org one week prior to the tournament and will be emailed out to each team captain.

Age Classifications and Player Eligibility:

B Division- Team is comprised mostly of B players, with the possibility of one or two A players and a few C players.

C Division- Team is comprised primarily of C level players with the possibility of one or two B players and NO A players.

Novice Division- Team is comprised primarily of Novice level players with the possibility of a few C level players; No A or B players!

A Level - Highest level. This player is highly skilled. Has played Junior A, College D-I, or is a former Pro. Also includes players who regularly play in an "A" league.

B Level - Competitive Player, Junior B or College Club (or D-II/D-III) type of player. Also includes players who regularly play in a "B" league and recent high school players (played HS hockey within last 5 years)

C Level - Less experienced recreational player or former High School player (more than 5 yrs ago). Includes players who regularly play in a "C" league

Novice Level: Began playing hockey as an adult

- All players **MUST** be at least **18 years old** by the first day of the tournament.
- Players must play in at least two round robin games to be eligible for championship games.
- Players may only be rostered on one team per division.
- All **teams and players** must be registered with **USA Hockey** by the start date of the tournament.
- **NO Player under contract with a Professional Team (NHL, CHL, AHL, etc.) within the last five years or coming year is allowed in the C or Novice Brackets of the tournament**

Game structure:

Warm-ups will be 3 minutes - beginning when the Olympia ® doors close. * Each period will be 12 minutes stop time. * One minute breaks between the periods. * Minor penalties are 2 minutes and majors are 5 minutes. * Each team is allowed one time out per game. * Redline will not be offside for "two line pass", and blue line icing will be used. * No Checking will be allowed. * Slapshots are allowed.

Tie Games:

If games are tied at the end of regulation time a five person round robin shootout will occur. The visiting team shall shoot first. If after five shooters the score is still tied, a sudden death shootout, with different shooters, will continue until a winner is determined. The first five shooters may not shoot again until all other players have gone.

Round Robin Point System:

During the round-robin, points are as follows (9 points total per game): 3 points/win; 2 points/shootout win; 1 point/shootout loss; 2 points/period won; 1 point/period tied. **The two teams in each division with the most points after the round-robin (3 games) will play against each other in the championship game for that division.**

Tiebreakers are as follows: 1) Head to head 2) Greatest goal differential (goals FOR minus goals AGAINST) 3) Fewest penalty minutes (in all round robin games); 10 minutes for a Game Misconduct 4) Coin toss

Discipline for excessive penalties:

*Four minor penalties or one major penalty carry an automatic game ejection.

*Any player receiving a game misconduct or match penalty shall be suspended from further tournament play.

*Fighting will not be tolerated. A fighting penalty or other excessive penalties may be grounds for expulsion from the tournament.

Equipment: Players are required to follow USA Hockey equipment recommendations.

"Sand Bag" Rule: If your team is declared by the Tournament Director to have "sand bagged" and registered in a division below the actual skill level of your team, you will be declared ineligible to play in the championship game of the Rec Havoc adult hockey tournament.

Our primary goal is to provide equitable compensation for all participating teams.
